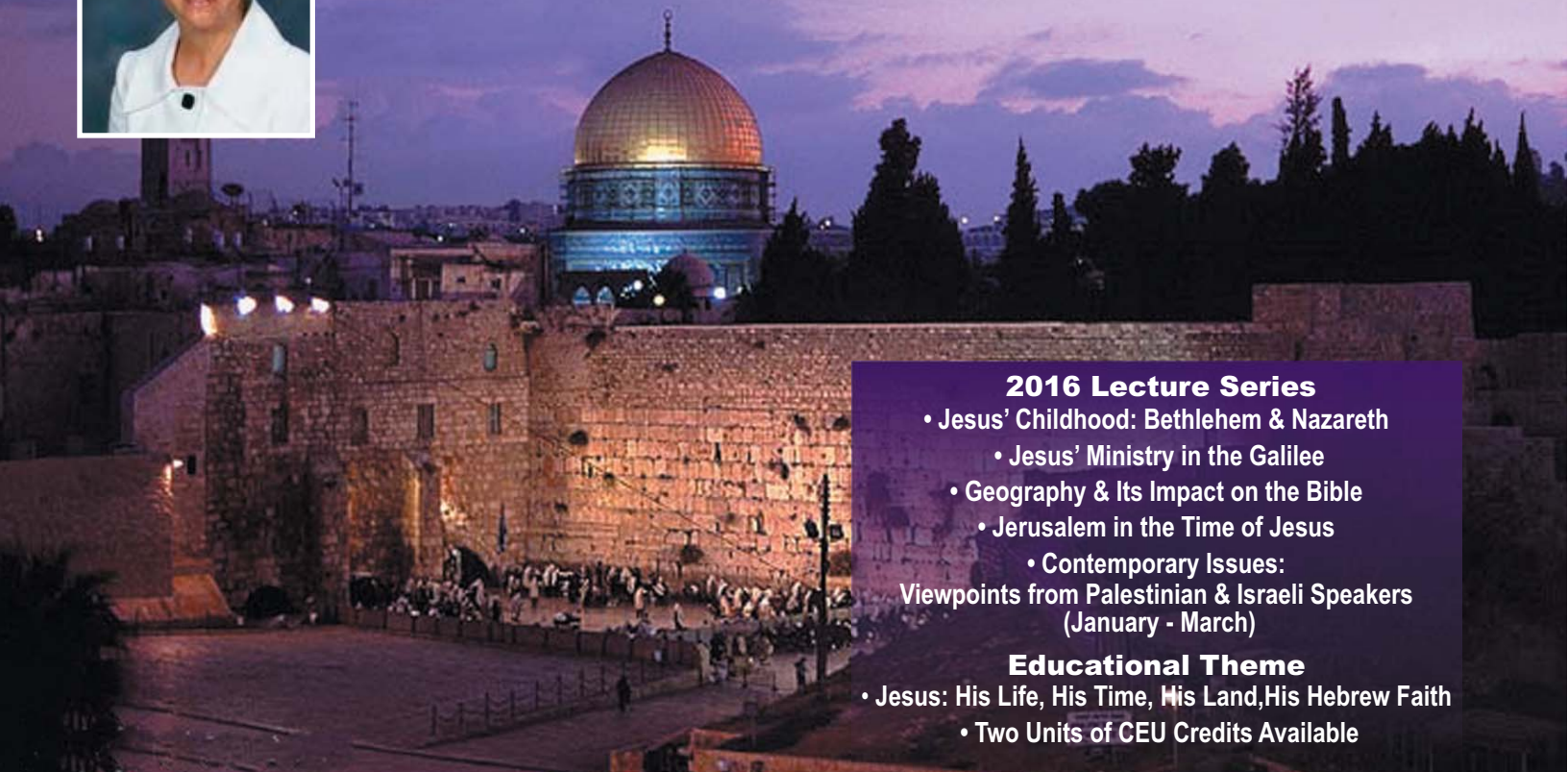

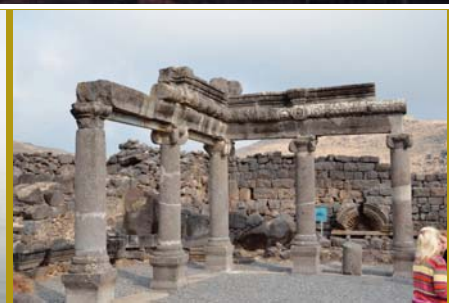

2016 ITINERARY

Day 1 & 2 – USA to the Holy Land

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed at the Tel Aviv airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel to enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.



Day 3 – The Galilee

Experience a special on-board worship service as you sail across the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy a beautiful drive to Capernaum, center of Jesus' ministry in the

Galilee, and visit the **synagogue** built on the site where Jesus taught (Matt.4:13, 23). On the **Mount of Beatitudes**, contemplate the words of the "Sermon on the Mount" Jesus preached there (Matt. 5-7). Explore the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** at **Tabgha**, traditional site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10). Take a moment to pray in the **Chapel of the Primacy**, where Peter professed his devotion three times to the risen Christ (John 21). Conclude your day at the **Jordan River** by recalling Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist.

Day 4 – Cana, Nazareth, Megiddo & Caesarea

Visit the **Franciscan Wedding church** in **Cana**, site of Jesus' first miracle, before continuing on to **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus (Matthew 2: 23). Overlook **Tel Megiddo (Armageddon)** to view one of the most important archaeological sites in Israel. End your day at **Caesarea**, a center of the early Christians, where an angel visited Cornelius, the first Gentile believer (Acts 10), and Paul was imprisoned for two years before appealing to Caesar for a hearing.



Day 5 – Jericho, Qumran & the Mount of Olives

As you stop in **Jericho** to view the ruins of the city conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6: 1, 2, 20), you can also see the traditional site of the **Temptation of Jesus** (Matt. 4:1-11). Continue on to **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947. End your day with a group picture taken atop the **Mount of Olives**, where Jesus ascended into heaven (Acts 1: 9-12).

EXTENSIONS

Wonders of Jordan & Petra 3-day extension \$798*

Day 10 – Cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. Mount Nebo, Madaba, Amman.

Day 11 – Petra. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 – Jerash.

Day 13 – Depart the Holy Land for the USA.

Cairo & the Route of the Exodus 4-day extension \$898*

Day 10 – Ancient caravan route to Mount Sinai for overnight.

Day 11 – Monastery of Saint Catherine, Wadi Feiran, Elim, Marah by the Red Sea. Dinner and overnight in Cairo.

Day 12 – Memphis, Sakkara, Step Pyramid. Great Pyramids of Giza, Sphinx.

Day 13 – King Tut's Treasure, Egyptian Museum, Citadel of Old Cairo, Coptic Church. Sail the Nile River aboard an authentic Egyptian Felucca.

Day 14 – Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.



Nile Cruise 7-day extension \$1548*

Day 10 & 11 – Same as Cairo and the Route of the Exodus.

Day 12 – Half day tour of Cairo: Egyptian Museum, King Tut's Treasures, Great Pyramids of Giza, Sphinx. This afternoon fly to Aswan and board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 – High Dam of Aswan, Granite Quarry, Unfinished Obelisk, Temple of Philae, Temple of Kom Ombo.

Day 14 – Temple of Horus in Edfu. Continue via the Nile Lock to Luxor.

Day 15 – Disembark. Visit the Necropolis of Thebes, Valley of the Kings and Queens, the Temple of Hatshepsut, Colossi of Memnon, Temples of Luxor and Karnak. Fly back to Cairo for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 & 17 – Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Day 6 – Bethlehem & Jerusalem

In **Bethlehem**, visit the cave revered as **Jesus’ birthplace** and the **world’s oldest church** constructed on the site (Matt. 1: 18-25). Visit the **Shepherds Field**—where the Good News was first proclaimed by angels—before returning to Jerusalem for a time of personal prayer in the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Matt. 26: 36-44). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas**, where Jesus was questioned (Matt. 26: 57-65) and meditate on the events of the Last Supper as you visit the **Upper Room** (Mark 14: 12-26).

Day 7 – Jerusalem & the Old City

Walk the **Cardo**, the main street of the Old City as you explore ancient Jerusalem at the **Teaching Steps**, the **Western Wall**, and the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5:1) where Jesus performed a Sabbath miracle. Sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne**, renowned for its amazing acoustics. Explore **Herod’s Antonia Fortress**, where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1), and follow in Christ’s steps on the **Via Dolorosa** ("the Way of the Cross"). At the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, reflect on His sacrificial love.

Day 8 – Leisure Day (Masada/Dead Sea option)

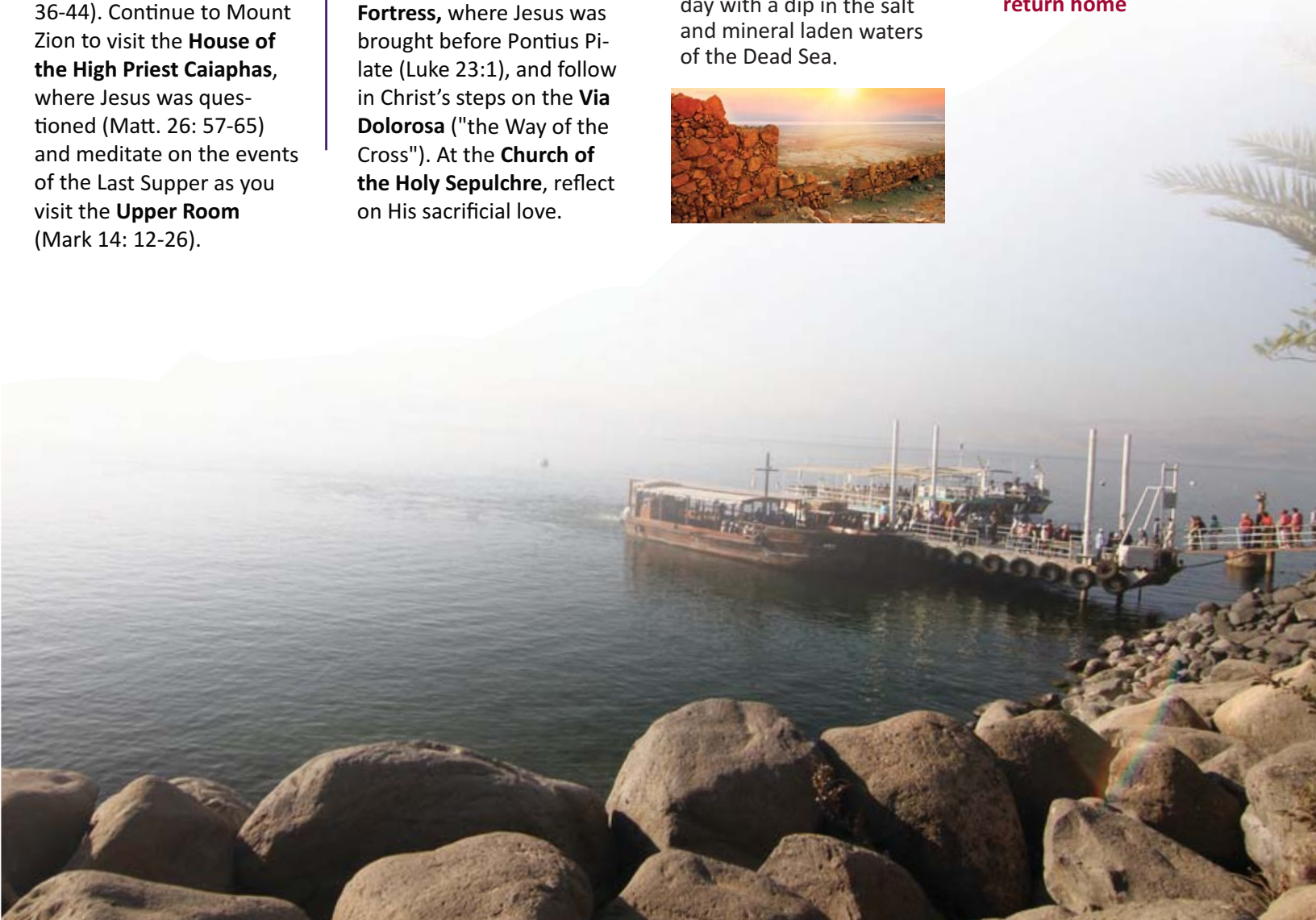
Explore on-your-own or visit **Masada** and the **Dead Sea** (additional charge). Ascend by cable car to Masada, Herod’s legendary mountaintop fortress which became the last desperate stronghold of the Jewish Zealots against the Romans. You can still look down on the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. End your day with a dip in the salt and mineral laden waters of the Dead Sea.



Day 9 – Jerusalem

Travel to **Ein Karem**, known as the birthplace of John the Baptist and the place where the Virgin Mary visited Elisabeth (Luke 1: 26-40). Visit **Yad Vashem**, Israel’s Holocaust Memorial. Your day culminates with a time of reflection at the **Garden Tomb**.
