## ELIGIBILITY

This ministry is to meet the emergency needs of Lake area residents. We do not give assistance to Sulphur residents as CareHelp of Sulphur services those residents.

- ⇒ Emergency needs such as recent unemployment illness, injury, unforeseen expenses, etc.
- ⇒ Financial Assistance eligible once per 12 months.
- ⇒ Food Assistance eligible once per 3 months.
