

Ministers Emergency Aid Fund

The Ministers' Emergency Aid Fund is supported by the clergy of the Louisiana Annual Conference who voluntarily contribute one-half of one percent of their base salary annually. The following guidelines were adopted at the 2015 Annual Conference:

1. Each clergyperson under appointment in the Louisiana Annual Conference is asked to give an amount equal to one-half of one percent of their base salary for 2015 to the Ministers' Emergency Aid Fund (line 5030 on the [Conference Remittance Form](#)).
2. The fund is to be used to provide emergency benefit aid to the clergy of the Louisiana Conference and their immediate families, subject to the following guidelines:
 - a. The maximum amount allowed for a single emergency shall be \$1,500.
 - b. Exceptional situations may be given special consideration by the Cabinet.
 - c. Only one grant will be provided to any one individual in a twelve month period.
3. Each clergyperson and local church be requested to provide an adequate medical insurance program for family protection.
